
Breaking News

MASTERCLASSES

NEAREST SUPER MARKET AND CASH POINT WALKING DISTANCE:

Go out main entrance turn RIGHT, the turn LEFT up Bracebridge drive, there is a parade of shops 200m on your left.

BIG SUPERMARKET:

Go out the main entrance and turn LEFT, go straight over 2 roundabouts until you come to a T junction controlled by traffic lights. Then...

ASDA (NG7 5FP): Turn LEFT. At roundabout turn Right. Next junction turn Right towards nottingham. At the next crossroads turn LEFT (Radford Rd).

SAINSBURY (NG7 1GX): Turn RIGHT. Continue down the ring road until you pass the Queens medical centre hospital, exit the dual carriageway onto the A6005. Follow this, cross one roundabout, at the traffic lights turn RIGHT.



While we have made every effort to ensure your safety and security, this is an open site so please ensure you, and especially your children are safe when moving between areas.



REMEMBER: Do not leave any valuables in your tent or car.


