Welcome to Whitstable and the first juggling convention to take place in the sunny Southeast. We have spent the last 12 months working on this event, and hope you get the chance to meet old friends, make new ones, show off your talents and have a fun-filled Easter weekend.

There is plenty happening on site with a clown show from Tweedy and Alexis, the fire and light spectacular on Friday night, the yo-yo competition, circus schools showcase, renegades, bands and DJs. Toby and Martin from the Fountain are providing the bar which opens early and closes late, whilst V and her crew from Tea & Times will be catering for all your culinary needs – light snacks in the bar, and cooked meals in the dining hall from 8am to 6pm most days.

And now for the JUGGLING: the sports hall is open 24 hours, with the traders open for business between 10am and 6pm. 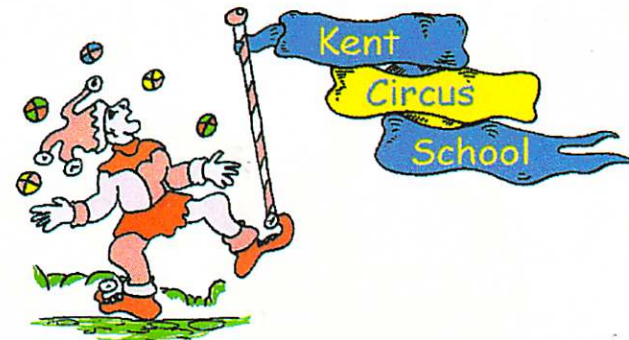

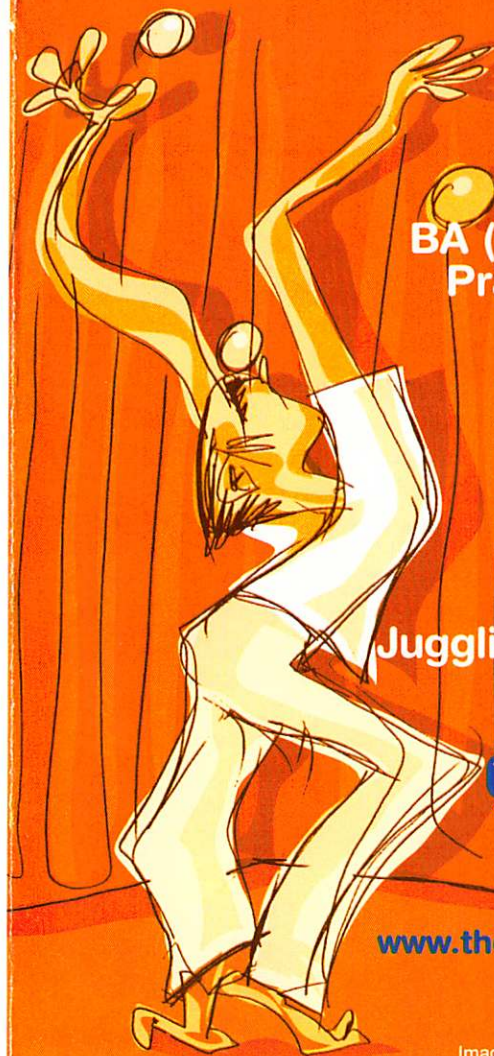
